Summary of Presentation:-

Dr. Vinay Ramani taught students game theory concepts through games, starting from "Prisoner's Dilemma", zero sum game, coordination, dominated strategy, Nash equilibrium, to pure and Mixed Strategies. Dr. Vinay made the topic easy to understand by giving real life examples such as daily flight fares, advertising, mergers and acquisitions, sequential and simultaneous moves, entry deterrence, collusive practices. He kept the entire class involved with Games with different approaches. He made students to think and give their best in solving the problems and developing the strategies before showing the solution to them.

He demonstrated that the Game theory may not always be a rational one as companies can achieve a higher pay-off by incentivizing the various parameters they take into consideration.

Students have shown great interest in this topic by actively participating in the games and interacting with the guest faculty. The session gave the students several insights and helped them in understanding the competition and strategies to compete in the market.
