And this, in turn, contributes to an imbalance of who's in control.

The conversation also emphasized on why female employees define leadership differently than some men do and how their potential and abilities are undisputable. The discussion ended on a positive note, emphasizing on how women make great leaders, and thus inspiring all the students.
